Declaration forms to be handed to the organiser 30 minutes before class is due to start, no changes to teams will be accepted once submitted and no major changes will be accepted after 7pm Thursday 18th February 2010. No entries for team events taken on the day. Teams will jump in a drawn order, all number 1 riders going first, followed by number 2 riders and so on in both rounds. All classes will be run under British Riding Club rules. Flu certificates will be checked in accordance with BRC rules, validity failure will incur elimination but competitors will be allowed to jump HC. Teams incurring elimination after the first round will also be allowed to jump HC in the second round. Tack will be checked in accordance with BRC rules and competitors must wear correct dress at all times, when riding. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any competitor for unsportsmanlike behaviour to others and or horse/pony. Any objections must be made within 30 minutes of the incident, in writing to the Show Secretary, accompanied by a £20 deposit, which, if upheld will be refunded. Neither the organisers of the event, nor the landowners, British Horse Society or any agent employed or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness, or injuries to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other persons whatsoever.
