ARENA 1

1. JUNIOR STYLE JUMPING.

Horses must not have won a total of more than £175 BS in affiliated BSJA competitions prior to the date of the close of preliminary entries or a total of more than 10 BE points.

FENCES: 85 cm. SPEED: 350mpm. 1 penalty point for every second or part of a second over the optimum time.

2. SENIOR STYLE JUMPING

Horses must not have won a total of more than £175 in BS in affiliated BSJA competitions prior to the date of the close of preliminary entries or a total of more than 10 BE points.

FENCES: 85 cm. SPEED: 350mpm. 1 penalty for every second or part of a second over the optimum time

3 JUNIOR NOVICE SHOW JUMPING.

Horses must not have won any money in BS in affiliated competitions other than Notional prize money gained in 70 cms or 80 cms classes held at BSJA intro prior to the date of the close of preliminary entries . May be registered with BE but must not have won any BE or IHTS points nor to have been placed 1 - 6th in any BE 100 competition.

FENCES: 80 cm. SPEED: 325mpm

4. JUNIOR INTERMEDIATE SHOW JUMPING.

Horses must not have won more than £400 in BSJA in affiliated BS competitions prior to the date of the close of preliminary entries.

FENCES: 95cm. SPEED: 325mpm

5. SENIOR NOVICE SHOW JUMPING..

Horses must not have won any money in BS than Notional prize money gained in 70 cm or 80 cm classes held at BSJA intro prior to the date of the close of preliminary entries .

FENCES: 80cm. SPEED: 325mpm

Horse and rider combinations that have been placed in the first 10 individually at the Novice outdoor Championships are not eligible to compete in the novice outdoor competition in the following year.

6. SENIOR INTERMEDIATE SHOW JUMPING.

Horses must not have won a total of more than £175 BS in affiliated BSJA competitions prior to the date of the close of preliminary entries

FENCES: 95cm. SPEED: 325mpm

Those horse and rider combinations that have been placed in the first 10 individually in the intermediate championships are not eligible to compete in the Intermediate or novice competitions in the following year.

7. SENIOR OPEN SHOW JUMPING.

Unlimited winnings. Open to all.

FENCES: 1.10 cm SPEED: 325mpm

Those horse and rider combinations that have been placed in the first 10 individually in the Open Championships are not eligible to compete in the Intermediate or Novice competitions in the following year

British riding club rules apply in all classes.

- Body protectors are strongly recommended for show jumping in all classes.
- All classes are run under current British Riding Club rules. A rule book will be available at the secretary's office.
- All horses / ponies must be 4yrs of age or over.
- If the event is cancelled there will be a refund of fees less a percentage to cover costs.
- Area 7 clubs will be expected to pay entry fees for the correct number of teams / individuals entered as at the preliminary stage (i.e. To Stoneleigh)
- Protests or complaints may only be lodged by the chairman or chef d'equipe or nominated representative of the club concerned in the area qualifiers or by a person 18 yrs of age or over in the open classes. These must be in writing and must be accompanied by a deposit of £20. They must be addressed to the Official Steward of the competition and be no later than 30 minutes after the occurrence, 30 minutes after the results have been published, or in the case of protests against the qualification of competitors or horses, 1 hour after the start of the class.. The disciplinary steward will give his decision after investigation and his decision will be final. The deposit will be forfeited unless the objection is upheld or it is decided there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the objection.

The organisers reserve the right to alter the order of classes as necessary. E.g. we may run the open show jumping first

A photographer will be present. Please inform the secretary if you do not wish you or your child to be photographed.

Please be sure to read all notices on the day. These will be at or near the secretary's or scoreboard. Other notices may be on gates or similar places.

Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/lanes and to avoid behaviour that might alarm horses. Dogs must be kept under close control and on leads at all times.

Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times and members of the public must not park vehicles so as to obstruct access. The organisers and landowner have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure a happy and safe event for all. Please obey instructions from officials and stewards immediately.

It is a condition of acceptance of your entry that you have read and agree to abide by the above rules and requests.
