Correct Riding attire, footwear and riding hats to EN1384 or PAS015 standard with the harness correctly fastened, must be worn by anyone riding anywhere at this competition. Hats prefixed SEI or ASTM are acceptable

The Riding Club accepts no liability for any thefts, accidents, damage, illness or injury, however caused to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever, save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence or organisers or anyone, for whom in law they are responsible.

Neither the organisers of the event, nor the landowners, British Horse Society, or any other agent employed or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injuries to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents, and accessories or any other persons or property whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.

It is recommended that owners/riders have adequate insurance to cover them at this event.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to a horse/competitor

No entry fee will be refunded unless a certificate accompanies withdrawal from either a doctor or veterinary surgeon

Any objections must be made to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident, in writing, accompanied by a deposit of £20 which will be returned if the objection is upheld
