Details of competition:

- 2 riders to ride Intro A (2008) dressage test with 60cm SJ
- 2 riders to ride Preliminary 14 (2006) dressage test with a 70cm SJ
- Teams of 4 can be mixed Juniors and Seniors in any combination
- Section A teams to be made up of four riders, all with 0 BD points and 0 BS winnings
- Section B teams may include riders with either BD points or BS winnings, but not in both disciplines
- SJ - Horse/rider combination must not have jumped any previous class in the same ring
- ALL RIDERS MUST BE CURRENT BRC AREA 7 MEMBERS
- Rosettes at each competition will be awarded to the first 6 teams and the first 6 individuals
