RING 1 SHOW JUMPING 9am

Class 1 Peter Pan Jumping – fences not to exceed 55cms in first round
Riders aged 12yrs and under (may be led). Prize in kind to winner.

Class 2 Pre Novice Jumping – fences not to exceed 65cms in first round
Results split Horses/Ponies. Prize in kind to winner.

Class 3 Novice Jumping – 75cm Open to All.
Results split Horses/Ponies. Prize money £10, £7, £5

Class 4 Area 7 Grassroots Combined Training SJ Class – 60cm
All riders must have completed their Intro Dressage Test prior to jumping this class.

Class 5 Area 7 Grassroots Combined Training SJ Class – 70cm
All riders must have completed their Prelim Dressage Test prior to jumping this class.

Class 6 Intermediate Jumping – 85cm Open to All
Results split Horses/Ponies. Prize money £10, £7, £5

Class 7 Small Open Jumping – 95cm Open to All

RULES

All classes to be run under BD/British Riding Club rules as appropriate. Any specific condition not covered by these rules will come under the jurisdiction of the British Horse Society.

- The judge's decision is final in all matters.
- Times quoted in the schedule are approximate only.
- Correct Riding attire, footwear and riding hats to EN1384 or PAS015 standard with the harness correctly fastened, must be worn by anyone riding anywhere at this competition. Hats prefixes SEI or ASTM are acceptable.
- The Riding club accepts no liability for any thefts, accidents, damage, illness or injury, however caused to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever, save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom in law they are responsible.
- Neither the organisers of the event nor the landowners, British Horse Society or any other agent employed or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injuries to horses, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other persons or property whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract, or in any other way whatsoever.
- It is recommended that owners/riders have adequate insurance to cover them at this event.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to a horse/competitor.
- No entry fee will be refunded unless a certificate accompanies withdrawal from either a doctor or veterinary surgeon.
- Any objections must be made to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the incident, in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £20 which will be returned if the objection is upheld.
- No horses/ponies under the age of 4yrs old to be ridden anywhere on the show ground.
- Competitor's age as at date of show.
- All dogs to be kept on a lead within the showground area.

BRC Area 7 Grassroots Combined Training:

A valid vaccination certificate must be held prior to competing on any horse/pony in the Combined Training classes. Riding hats must be tagged.
