INDOOR ARENA

1. **Junior Novice Team qualifier.**

Horses/ ponies to have 0 BS winnings other than notional prize money gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows.

0 BE points and must not have been placed in the first 6 in a BE 100 competition in the current or previous calendar year at the time of preliminary entry. If BRC downgraded please include a copy of the letter with entry.

Jumps in the first round 80cms. Second round 85 cms approx.

2. **Senior novice team qualifier.**

Horses/ ponies to have 0 BS winnings other than notional prize money gained in 70cm and 80 cm classes held at BS Intro shows.

0 BE points and must not have been placed in the first 6 in a BE 100 competition in the current or previous calendar year at the time of preliminary entry. If BRC downgraded please include a copy of the letter with entry.

Jumps in the first round 80cms. Second round 85 cms approx.

1. BRC RWHS SHOW SENIOR INTERMEDIATE TOP SCORE JUMPING QUALIFIER.

TOP SCORE RULES SUMMARY BELOW: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

A SUMMARY OF THE TOP SCORE RULES.

FOR A FULL SET OF RULES PLEASE SEE BRC AND RWHS WEBSITE.

THIS IS AN INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION. NO TEAMS.

1. BS rule 273 applies unless stated otherwise.
2. The course will consist of 12 obstacles, each of which must be capable of being jumped in either direction. Fences 1-11 will be of differing heights and each will carry a points value ranging from 20-120. The 12th fence will be a Joker fence worth 200 points.

Class	Fence 1 (20 points)	Fence 11 (120 points)	Joker (200 points)
Novice	60 cm	80 cm	90 cm
Intermediate	75 cm	1m	1m 5 cm

3. Order of starting will be drawn
4. Water jumps and combination obstacles not allowed
5. Time allowed is 60 secs
6. The Round starts when the competitor crosses the start line in either direction
7. The competitor chooses which fences to jump and may do so in either direction
8. The competitor scores the number of points allotted to each obstacle, provided it is jumped clear.
9. An obstacle which is knocked down or displaced will not be re built. This includes the displacement of a lower element in the same vertical plane.
10. Each obstacle may be jumped twice to score. Jumping voluntary or otherwise, an obstacle for the third or subsequent time, or jumping or passing through an obstacle already knocked down or displaced, including the displacement of a lower element does not incur elimination but scores NO points.

11. Disobediences are not penalised, but a judge may eliminate a competitor if it becomes apparent that repeated disobediences have destroyed all chances of the competitor featuring in the prize list
12. The bell is rung when the time is reached. The competitor must then cross the finishing line in either direction.
13. If a horse has taken off at the last fence before the bell is rung, then that score will count.
14. The Joker may be jumped twice to score but if it is knocked down then 200 points will be deducted.
15. In event of equality of points then time decides.
16. Horses/ ponies may only compete in one section.
17. Riders who qualify will be given a qualifying card which MUST be signed by the Area Steward officiating at the Area qualifier
18. The qualification card MUST accompany the entry for the Championships at RWHS.
19. Riders must be a member of an affiliated RC in the local area to take part in the qualifier.
20. BRC flu vac rules apply.

RULES

1. BRC rules will apply in all classes
2. Body protectors are strongly recommended for show jumping
3. All horses / ponies must be 4 years of age or over
4. All clubs are expected to pay the organisers for the correct number of teams and competitors, as entered at the preliminary stage to Stoneleigh.
5. Protests and/ or complaints must be lodged in writing together with a deposit of £20 within 30 minutes of the occurrence of the dispute/query or 30 minutes after the results are posted. The Official Steward will investigate and his/her decision will be final. The deposit will be returned if the objection is upheld or it is decided that there were good and reasonable grounds for lodging the objection
6. A photographer may be present. If you object to your photo being taken please inform the secretary at declaration time.

7. Horses/ ponies can be easily frightened and may become dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear from horse areas/ lanes and to avoid behaviour which may alarm horses
8. Dogs must be on a lead and under control at all times.
9. Emergency services must have access to all parts of the event site at all times and all people are requested not to park so as to restrict access.
10. It is a condition of acceptance of entry that you have read and agree to abide by these and any H&S rules, requests and notices at all times
